One-on-One Assistants at Practice

Our policy states that families must provide a person to assist at practice for athletes with behavior or attention issues. Typically this person is a family member, but we are seeing an increase in trained 1:1 technicians that are funded via the autism waiver. These 1:1 technicians are not required to attend a SO Volunteer orientation as their only responsibility during a practice is to manage behaviors for the one athlete under their charge. These trained assistants have liability insurance through the service provider. We encourage all family members that take on a 1:1 role to attend a volunteer orientation in order to be covered if a liability issue would arise.
