SOHO Athlete Arrival/Pickup Policy

The policies for Arrival/Pick-up of Athletes and Transportation pertain to and affect us all.

As a result, below is a reminder of these important policies, specifically as they relate to our practices. We are all responsible to adhere to these policies.

Points of Contact for athletes living outside of their family home, please make sure this information is distributed beforehand to anyone that may be dropping off or picking up an athlete.

Arrival/Pick-up of Athletes:

- -Be sure that athletes are dropped off at practice on time.
 - Practice begins promptly at (6:00) (early dark day 5:30)
 - If your athlete needs time to prepare (e.g., change shoes, set up chair, etc.) be sure that athlete is ready to go at the practice start time.
 - Athletes arriving late disrupt the practice and late arrival should be avoided.
- -Parents or chaperones (anyone dropping off an athlete) must escort their athlete into the practice location, check-in with the Coordinator or Site Lead, and must leave a contact phone number if they are not staying for the practice/competition.
 - The Coordinator/Site Lead can then contact the parent/chaperone in the
 event that practices ends early or if there is an issue with the athlete. This
 will also prevent athletes from being dropped off at practice locations when
 the practice has been moved or cancelled.
 - Coordinator (*Shirley Duhaney*)
- -Parents/chaperones must return 15 minutes prior to the end of practice.
 - Practice officially ends at (7:30). This means that parents/chaperones must be at the practice site by (7:15). (When it starts getting dark early practice will end at 7pm)
 - Occasionally, practice could end early, and someone needs to be there to pick up athletes.
 - It is NOT the job/responsibility of the Coordinator or Site Lead to call the Parent/Chaperone at the end of practice.
- -Because outdoor practices are subject to unpredictable weather, parents/chaperones must stay on site if the weather is questionable.

-Although contact information is provided in the online registration, the person responsible for the drop off/pick up of athletes sometimes changes from week to week and as a result, the parent/chaperone must check-in with the Coordinator/Site Lead and complete the sign out sheet made available.
